### 3. Treasurer's Report

- Drama Club make it less expensive & more equitable for ppl participating, pay Molly more (currently takes home \$20k which includes costume and staff, made \$46k and cost \$32k (possibly invest in schools) THANK YOU BECCA FOR AN INCREDIBLE PROGRAM THIS YEAR!
  - PTA to purchase wireless mics to be used for other activities besides Drama Club

## 4. Approve 2025-2026 Budget

- UPDATES to Budget:
  - Jill requests a \$2k budget (vs. \$500) change made before approval
  - Becca requests Drama Club projected expenses change from \$26k to \$32k (will likely be buying items and building up the program next year)
  - BOTH changes made in the budget before approval
- Auction–kept projected income at \$25k and transition auction to more of a social activity and focus more on experiences and teacher parties
- Focusing more on community engagement/grade-wide social events throughout the year?
  - IDEA FOR BACK-TO-SCHOOL NIGHT: Savy proposed to have teachers lead quick icebreakers for parents at Back-to-School night, or have a social for all parents before in the APR (like 30 min before?) to encourage community engagement and socializing
- o Becca motioned to approve the budget, Jill seconded, all approved.

### 5. Boundary Study

o Brookmont would be the only potentially affected area in the BES boundary that would be switched to Westland (from Pyle). Every other BES area would be Pyle.

### 6. Community Service

- TBD Mural on shipping container (potential local artist in mind) which would depict native plants, wildlife (+ bobcat!)

- Looking into doing something small around the rock, down where old BES sign is/rebuild rock wall, stones on walkway, removing old planters that are outside.
